New ID Cards: When you received your UMR ID card in June 2018, it did not include the POMCO Dental Network Logo. UMR mailed you a new ID card the last week in May which now includes the POMCO Dental Network Logo on the back of the ID card. If you have not destroyed your old ID Card and replaced it with the new ID Card, please do this immediately.

UMR is in the process of identifying and notifying members affected as it is possible that you did not receive the appropriate discount for services from an in-network POMCO Dental Network provider between July 1, 2018 and April 1, 2019 due to the logo's absence on the ID Card.
