Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This letter is two-fold: 1) To thank the Brothers and Sisters in Local 43 who have voluntarily contributed to the Brotherhood Fund, not only currently, but for years. Your contributions have helped our sick or injured members in their time of need. Contributions also helped us to fund social activities that bring us closer together as a true Brotherhood. You, through your voluntary check-off, exhibit the very best of the old saying "one for all and all for one". Your ongoing support of the Brotherhood Fund exemplifies the thought that we are indeed our brothers' keepers.

In 2014, we did a study to check the participation level in our Brotherhood Fund. The number of working members then donating to the fund was 56%, while the number not contributing was 44%. Currently we have 65% contributing and 35% that do not contribute.

So, with that in mind we need to address the second part of our two-fold letter: 2) We would respectfully ask members who currently do not contribute to the Brotherhood Fund to revisit their decision not to participate. While it is true we have not hosted many social events recently, that was based on the financial status of our Fund. The Committee made the decision that it would be best to help those members in need rather than spend money on social events. Many events that at one time were paid for from the Brotherhood Fund are now paid out of our General Fund. The Committee has done everything in our power to spend the money that we receive in the best way for the entire membership. In order for us to fulfill the mission statement of those visionary Brothers and Sisters who established the Fund years ago, we need more members to contribute.

Since 2013, the Brotherhood Fund has given over \$101,000.00 to over 150 Brothers and Sisters who were out of work with health-related issues and in need of assistance. We have made a positive difference in their lives.

Please feel free to ask us any questions concerning how the Fund revenues are handled. In the spirit of Brotherhood, we are asking that you help us to increase the number of ways we can improve the lives of our members and their families. If you are not currently participating, please call the Union office to request that a Deduction Authorization form be mailed to you.
