New Union Dues for 2018

The delegates to the 39th IBEW International Convention held in 2016 authorized a Per Capita payment increase to be paid to the International Office. Accordingly, effective Jan. 1, 2018, all dues payments covering Jan. 2018 through Dec. 2018 will increase three dollars (\$3.00) per quarter.

Dues payments for 2018 are \$112.50 per quarter.

 1^{st} Qtr. is owed in January, 2^{nd} Qtr. is owed in April, 3^{rd} Qtr. is owed in July, 4^{th} Qtr. is owed in October.

Dues are to be paid at least quarterly in advance. You can pay ahead either:

- 1 Quarter (3 Months) = \$ 112.50
- 1/2 Year (6 Months) = \$ 225.00
- ¾ Year (9 Months) = \$ 337.50
- Full Year (12 Months) = \$450.00

A \$30.00 reinstatement fee will be charged if payment is received later than the end of each quarter.

News from the Insurance and Pension Fund Office:

Effective January 1, 2018, pursuant to the Inside Construction Agreement ("Agreement" or "CBA"), New York State Paid Family Leave and New York State Disability coverage will be provided for members performing covered work under that CBA through a Ullico insurance policy obtained by the CBA parties.

For those that are eligible under the terms of the insurance policy, the new Paid Family Leave benefit includes partial wage replacement and continued health care for approved time away from work.

In general, Paid Family Leave allows eligible members to take leave from work for the following reasons:

- To bond with a newly born, adopted or foster child;
- Care for a spouse, your child, domestic partner, parent, grandparent, grandchild with a serious health condition; or
- Active duty deployment of a spouse, your child, domestic partner or parent.
